Media Alert: Grand Opening of Newcomer Settlement Agency in North-East Brampton

What: Malton Neighbourhood Services (MNS) invites you to attend the Grand Opening of their new Brampton centre, MNS Multicultural Newcomer Services.

Highlight for the grand opening include speeches by local politicians, a ribbon cutting ceremony, ESL students reciting John McCrae's *In Flanders Field* poem to mark Remembrance Day, humorous skits on cultural misinterpretations and henna applications. Refreshments will also be served.

The new centre provides free newcomer settlement services, including the popular Job Search Workshops, Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC), general citizenship information, assistance with translation of documents and more.

The new centre, funded by Citizenship and Immigration Canada, will greatly benefit the under-served North-east Brampton community, which has seen a dramatic increase in population but is still working on new infrastructure and support services to keep up with its growing population.
