****Peel Infant Development-**

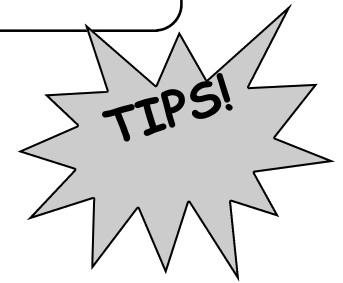
An OEYC consultant will be here to answer any questions you may have about infant's development.

Here are some tips to assist you in making -
Family Literacy a priority in your home:



- 1. Make reading part of your child's world. -**
Read books with them and to them, aiming for a total of 30 minutes of book-sharing time each day.
- 2. Ask deeper questions. -**
Help your child build comprehension skills by asking questions about the story.
- 3. Help your child when they need it. -** If they make a mistake but is close, quickly repeat the word correctly and let them continue without interrupting the flow.
- 4. Praise them. -** Encourage your child by praising their efforts, paying attention when they want to read, and making your reading time together fun.
