Duties:

- Implement day-to-day camp schedule for children ages 6-12 years
- build a fun atmosphere with enjoyable physical activities, while still educating campers throughout the day
- Ensure the development and implementation of daily/weekly camp program schedules
- Provide leadership to the camp participants
- Ensure consistent communication with parents and/or caregivers
- Health and safety of camp participants
- Support and monitor all children participating in camp
- Ensure all camp related activity requirements are complete (i.e. booking trips for program, organizing games or crafts, etc.)
- Encourage camp participants to follow proper hygiene
- Be a role model and participate in all camp program activities
- Maintain required documentation related to attendance records, permission forms, program plans, incident reports, and other administrative functions
- Build positive relationships with camp staff, participants, volunteers, parents and/or caregivers
- Follow all policies and procedures as required, and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Ability to effectively communicate in English
- Experience/skill in all or one of the followings: sports & recreation, arts & crafts, dance, drama, music
- Leadership experience or skills, particularly with children aged 6-12 years
- Ability to think quickly and work well under pressure in a fast-paced environment
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with both children and adults
- Ability to plan and organize fun and creative program plans for the campers
- Ability to work individually as well as in a team, within a multicultural environment
- Must be able to work in outdoor/indoor environments
- Must be returning to high school or attending post-secondary in the fall
