The Camp Counsellor would organize and implement recreational summer activities for children ages 6-12.

- Plan, organize and participate in physical, recreational, and creative activities
- Ability to work in outdoor and indoor environments, and to stand within the pool to monitor children
- Monitor records of attendance & registration
- Create and maintain a safe environment for campers, using a proactive approach
- Promote learning & cultural sensitivity among campers
- Act as a positive role model, support & mentor to children

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to effectively communicate in English
- Experience/skill in all or one of the followings: sports & recreation, arts & crafts, dance, drama, music
- Leadership experience or skills, particularly with children aged 6-12 years
- Ability to think quickly and work well under pressure in a fast-paced environment
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with both children and adults
- Ability to plan and organize fun and creative program plans for the campers
- Ability to work individually as well as in a team, within a multicultural environment
- Must be able to work in outdoor/indoor environments, and to stand within the pool to monitor children

Applicants must be: between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment; registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year; intends to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year; is

currently enrolled in a secondary, post-secondary, vocational or technical program; is a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and is legally entitled to work in Canada. International students are not eligible to apply.
